EARLY VOTING BEGINS NEXT WEEK FOR NOVEMBER 7, 2023, SPECIAL ELECTION

SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF – The November 7, 2023, Special Election is fast approaching, and eager voters will have the opportunity to cast their ballot at the Registrar of Voters' Office or at an Official Drop Box when early voting begins next Monday, October 9.

"No matter the size of the election, our staff are always ready to help the voters of Santa Clara County make their voices heard," said Registrar of Voters Shannon Bushey.

For this Special Election, there are two contests on the ballot:

- San José-Evergreen Community College District Governing Board Member
 - Trustee Area 7 only, Short-Term
- Los Altos School District, Parcel Tax - Measure A

Starting Monday, early voting will be available at the Registrar of Voters' Office for individuals wishing to drop off their ballot or vote in person during normal business hours, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. The office is located at 1555 Berger Drive, Building #2, San Jose, CA 95112.

Voters may also drop off their ballot at one of thirteen (13) Official Drop Box locations, which will be open 24 hours a day, and on Election Day until 8 p.m. To find the nearest Official Drop Box locations, visit rovservices.sccgov.org.

Voters can track the status of their ballot by registering at wheresmyballot.sos.ca.gov. Once subscribed, they will receive notifications by text, email, or phone when their ballot is mailed, received, and counted.
