## REGISTRAR OF VOTERS' OFFICE IS PREPARING FOR A NOVEMBER 7, 2023 SPECIAL ELECTION

**SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF** – With the November 7, 2023 Special Election just seventy-six days away, the Registrar of Voters' office is bustling with activity. Preparing for an election takes months of planning, even for local elections. For this election, there are two contests on the ballot:

- San José-Evergreen Community College District Governing Board Member
  Trustee Area 7 only, Short-Term
- Los Altos School District, Parcel Tax Measure A

Ballots for this Special Election will be mailed out to those voters who reside within these two districts by Monday, October 9, 2023. The Registrar of Voters office is also available for Early Voting starting Monday, October 9. You can drop off your ballot or vote in person during normal business hours, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Numerous Official Drop Boxes will also be placed in these two districts for the voters to return their completed ballots starting October 9, 2023.

A total of four (4) Vote Centers will be open for the November Special Election. Three (3) Vote Centers will be open Saturday, October 28 – Monday, November 6 from 9:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. and on Tuesday, November 7 from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. The three Vote Centers will be located at:

"Voters may return their ballot safely and securely," said Registrar of Voters Shannon Bushey, "by mail, at an official drop box, at any Vote Center, or by authorizing someone else to return their ballot by completing the authorization section on the ballot return envelope."

Per county regulations, safety protocols will be observed for the protection of all voters and Vote Center staff. Curbside voting will be available for those who cannot leave their vehicles or prefer not to walk into the Vote Center.
