Central Way, Delia Street, Empey Way, Leland Avenue, Moorpark Avenue,
Summit Avenue and Thornton Way**

Dear Resident,

The County of Santa Clara Board of Supervisors has established Residential Parking Permit areas in your neighborhood. Residential Parking Permit areas were established to ease parking congestion in residential areas adjacent to commercial areas or other parking-impacted areas.

Your current parking permit is set to expire on December 31st of this year. Your residence is entitled to receive two (2) parking permits. There is no cost for the permits.

Due to building renovations occurring at our Roads and Airports Department Administrative Offices, we are mailing the new permits to each residence. Enclosed are two permits/hangtags.

Hangtags must be displayed by hanging on the rear-view mirror so the number can be read through the front windshield from the outside. Remove the hangtag before vehicle is in motion.

Permits are non-transferable and cannot be sold. If a permit is lost or stolen, please contact the Roads and Airports Permits Issuance staff at 408-573-2475 for a replacement. If you have any questions about this letter, please call our Permits Issuance staff at 408-573-2475.
