Section XX: Nurse Practitioner Area Lead and Lead Pay:

The Lead Nurse Practitioner works under the direction of the Director of Advanced Practice and shall receive an additional 5% lead differential above base rate of pay. Positions in this class provide clinical care to patients in the specialty area and have additional duties to assist the Director of Advanced Practice. They also develop appropriate policies and procedures and assist with training and supervision of nurse practitioners in their specialty/area of practice. The job distribution is expected to be 80% clinical 20% administrative time.

In the event Nurse Practitioners are required to perform additional supervisory duties outside their normal scope of practice, including but not limited to "Doctor of the Day", the Nurse Practitioner will received a premium differential of five percent (5%) above the base rate of pay.
