

RETAIL FOOD WORKER SURVEY


SANTA CLARA COUNTY

County of Santa Clara's Office of Labor Standards Enforcement (OLSE) is partnering with the University of California, Berkeley, Labor Occupational Health Program (LOHP), and local community partners to conduct a survey to document the issues facing retail food workers. The purpose is to capture information on working conditions to inform current and future policies to ensure safe employment that complies with all relevant labor laws.



UC Berkeley has designed a survey in collaboration with OLSE and grassroots community organizations. Local community partners with ties to worker communities will recruit and administer the survey. UC Berkeley will analyze the data and provide a report describing the results of the survey to the OLSE. Participation of workers at a range of retail food establishments is critical to the success of this survey.
