EARLY VOTING BEGINS NEXT WEEK FOR MAY 7, 2024, SPECIAL MAIL BALLOT ELECTION

SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF – The May 7, 2024, Special Mail Ballot Election for the Los Gatos-Saratoga Union High School District which is shared with Santa Cruz County, is quickly approaching and voters registered in this district will have the opportunity to cast their ballots.

Voters may drop off their ballot at one of seven Official Drop Box locations, open 24 hours a day, until 8 p.m. on Election Day. To find the nearest Official Drop Box location and to look up your district, visit https://rovservices.sccgov.org/. Voting hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday and until 8 p.m. on Election Day.

Voters can track the status of their ballot by registering at https://wheresmyballot.sos.ca.gov/. Once subscribed, they will receive notifications by text, email, or phone when their ballot is mailed, received, and counted.
