The Santa Clara County Medical Examiner-Coroner's Office has made the positive identification of Alfred Anderson, DOB 8/23/1930, who died on 11/16/1987. Despite efforts, this office has been unable to locate Alfred Sherman Anderson's family and is seeking assistance to do so.

On 11/16/1987, Alfred Sherman Anderson was found deceased beneath an automatic teller machine located in the rear of American Savings located at 66 W. Santa Clara Street in San Jose, CA.

Alfred Anderson weighed 145 pounds and measured 64 inches tall. He was described as a 57-year old Caucasian male with grey-brown hair and grey eyes.

He was wearing the below clothing at the time of his death:

- Red windbreaker marked with "Half Moon Bay Parks and Rec"
- Checkered gray-green sport shirt, size small
- Gray short sleeved pullover with marked "Pebble Beach"
- White T-shirt in marked 7C-Celosi, size extra large
- Gray pants with a light brown belt
- White socks
- Blue deck shoes, size 8

Information has been uploaded into the National Missing and Unidentified Persons System (NamUs) which is a national centralized repository and resource center for missing, unidentified, and unclaimed person cases across the United States. NamUs provides technology, forensic services, and investigative support to resolve missing person and unidentified remains cases.
