Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 15620, the County of Santa Clara will conduct a voter-requested recount for the Santa Clara County portion of Congressional District 16.

The initial schedule of the recount is: **Monday through Friday
8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
Lunch break: 12:00 p.m. to 12:30 p.m.**

Recount results, as well as any announcements, notices, or changes to the schedule, will be posted online at sccvote.org and at the Office of the Registrar of Voters.

By law, the requestor is responsible for paying a deposit for the estimated cost of each day's recount activities by the beginning of that day. If the deposit is not paid by the requestor, the recount will end unless and until another voter submits a request to continue the recount within 24 hours.

The recount is open to the public to observe, although the number of observers may be limited as needed due to space, safety, and security constraints. Advanced scheduling is not required to observe, however, as a courtesy, parties interested in observing are asked to contact the Registrar of Voters at (408) 282-3241 or registrar@rov.sccgov.org to help facilitate this process.

Pursuant to the request for recount and ballot inspection, this recount will be conducted as a machine recount as detailed in California Elections Code Section 15627.
