OFFICIAL RESULTS CERTIFIED FOR THE NOVEMBER 5 PRESIDENTIAL GENERAL ELECTION

SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF. – The County of Santa Clara Registrar of Voters' Office (ROV) certified the official results of the November 5 Presidential General Election today.

"I want to wish a heartfelt thank you to every voter who made their voice heard in this election," said Acting Registrar of Voters Matt Moreles, "I would also like to commend our incredible staff who worked tirelessly to ensure that we conducted a fair and accurate election, and who made voting easy and accessible for all. We are extremely proud to serve the voters of Santa Clara County."

The final turnout for this Presidential General Election totaled 765,495 ballots cast, representing 72.99% of the 1,048,723 registered voters in Santa Clara County.

The Official Canvass was conducted by the ROV to complete the official counting of all qualified ballots. Ballot envelopes with missing or mismatched signatures were "cured" and a manual tally was conducted for one percent of the precincts in the election.

The contests for Cupertino City Council and Palo Alto City Council required automatic recounts, where the margin of victory for the candidates was either less than 0.25% of the total number of ballots cast or less than 25 votes. The recounts were completed prior to certification and results are included in the official results.
