If there is an asterisk (\*) by the date, the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday and, in most cases, has been moved to the next business day.

| <p><b>June 20, 2023</b><br/>(E-35)</p>  | <p><b>List of Voters Qualified</b></p> <p>At least 35 days prior to the date fixed for the landowner district election, the secretary of a landowner district for which an election has not been cancelled pursuant to Section 10515, shall deliver to the county election official (Election Office) of each affected county a list of voters qualified under the principal act of that district to vote in that county at the next landowner district election.</p> | <p>§10525</p>        |
| <p><b>July 5, 2023</b><br/>(E-20)</p>   | <p><b>Ballots Out to Qualified Landowner Voters</b></p> <p>Between these dates, candidates must file their Declaration of Candidacy and Nomination Papers.</p>  | <p>§10527</p>        |
