

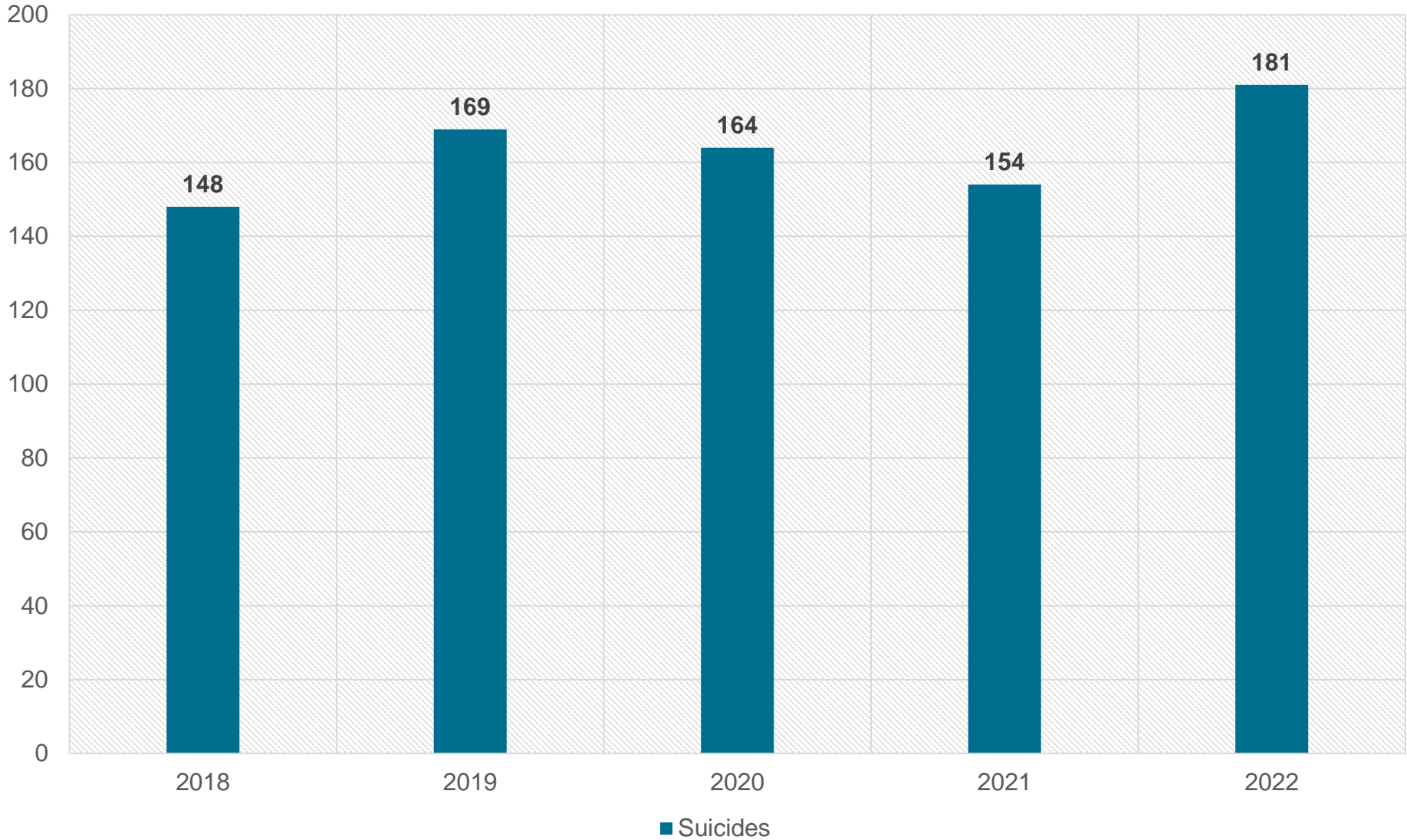

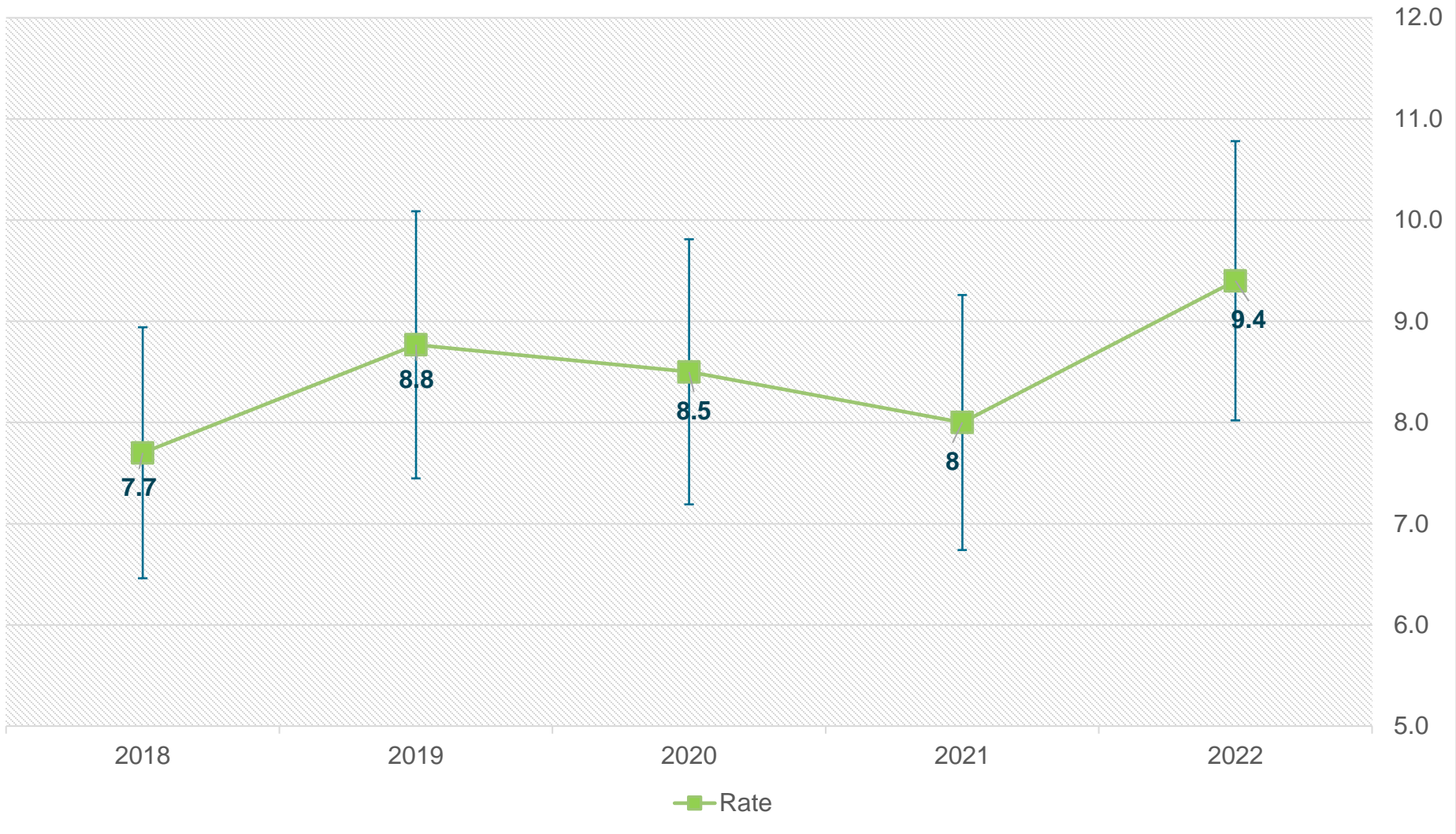

Number of Suicides in Santa Clara County, by Year

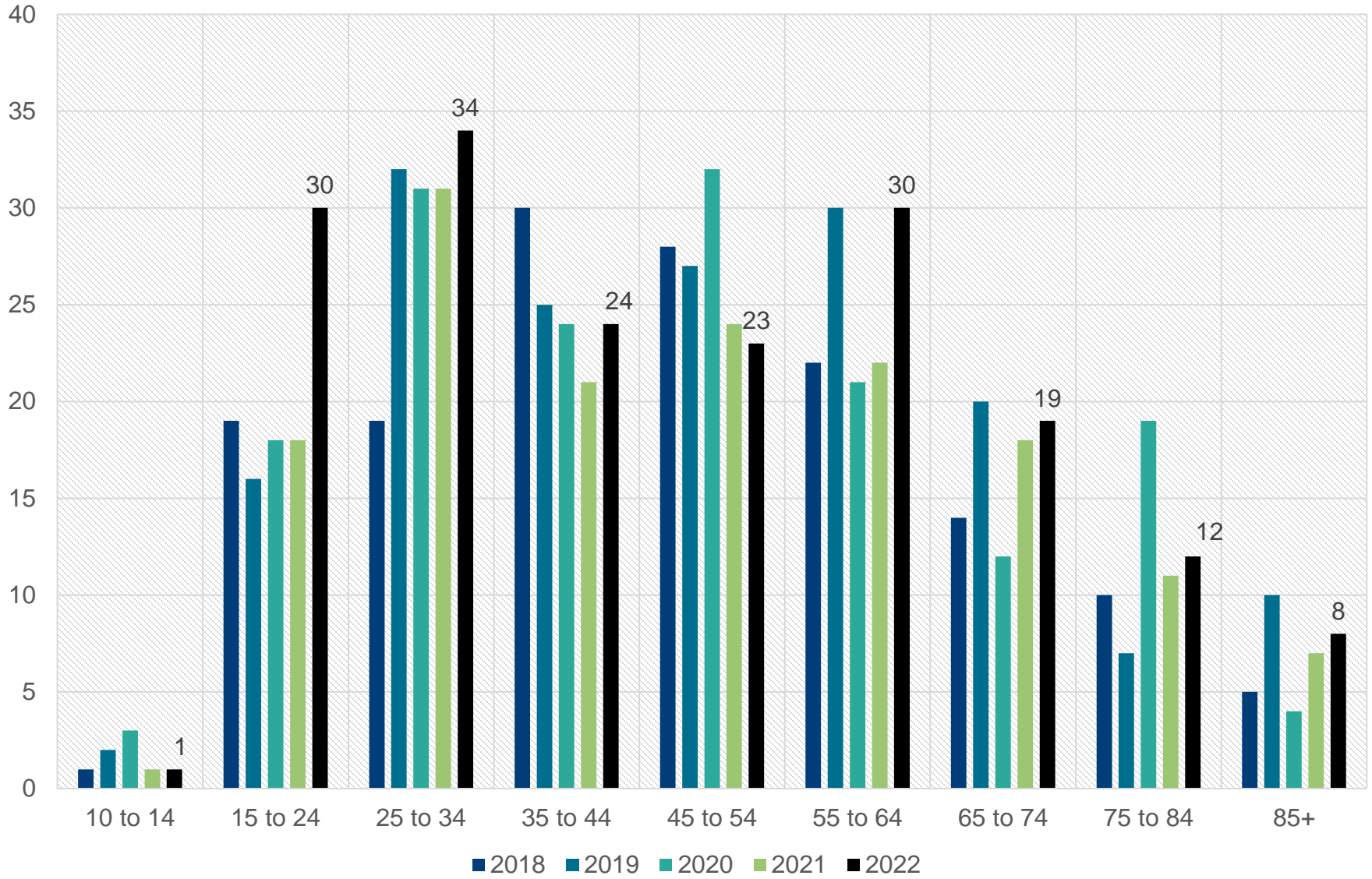


Suicide Rate per 100,000 in Santa Clara County, by Year

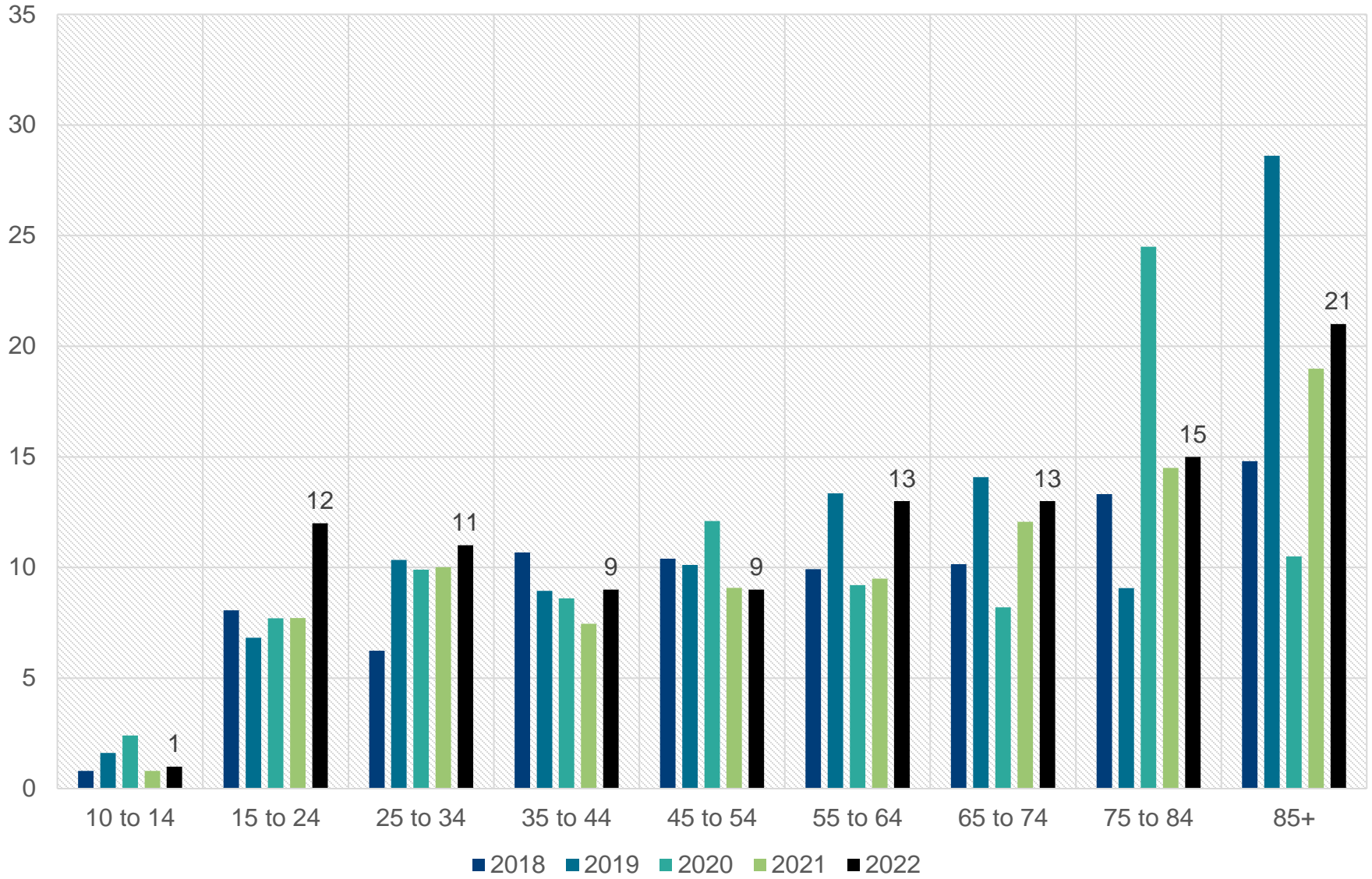

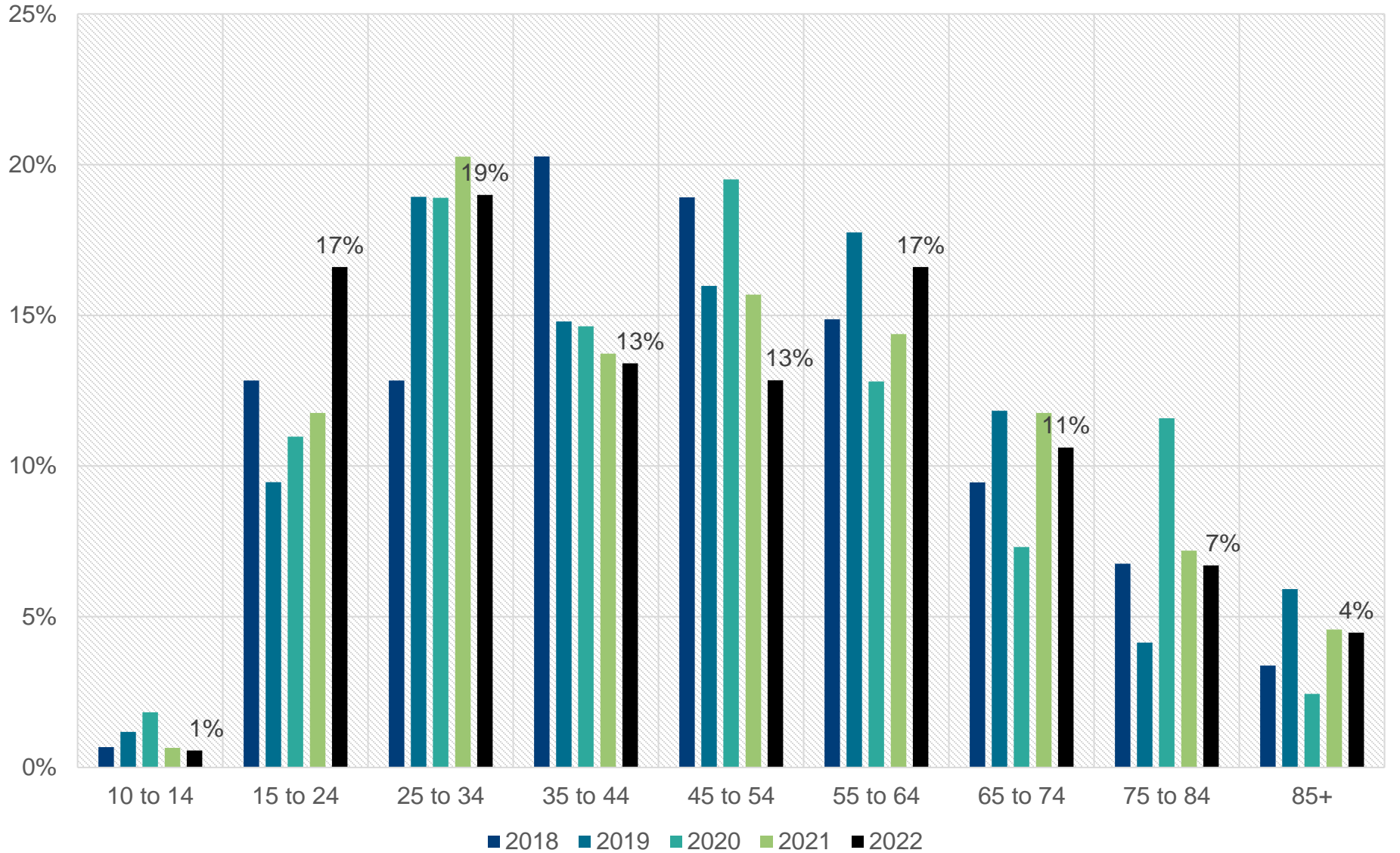
Yearly Suicide Count by Age Range



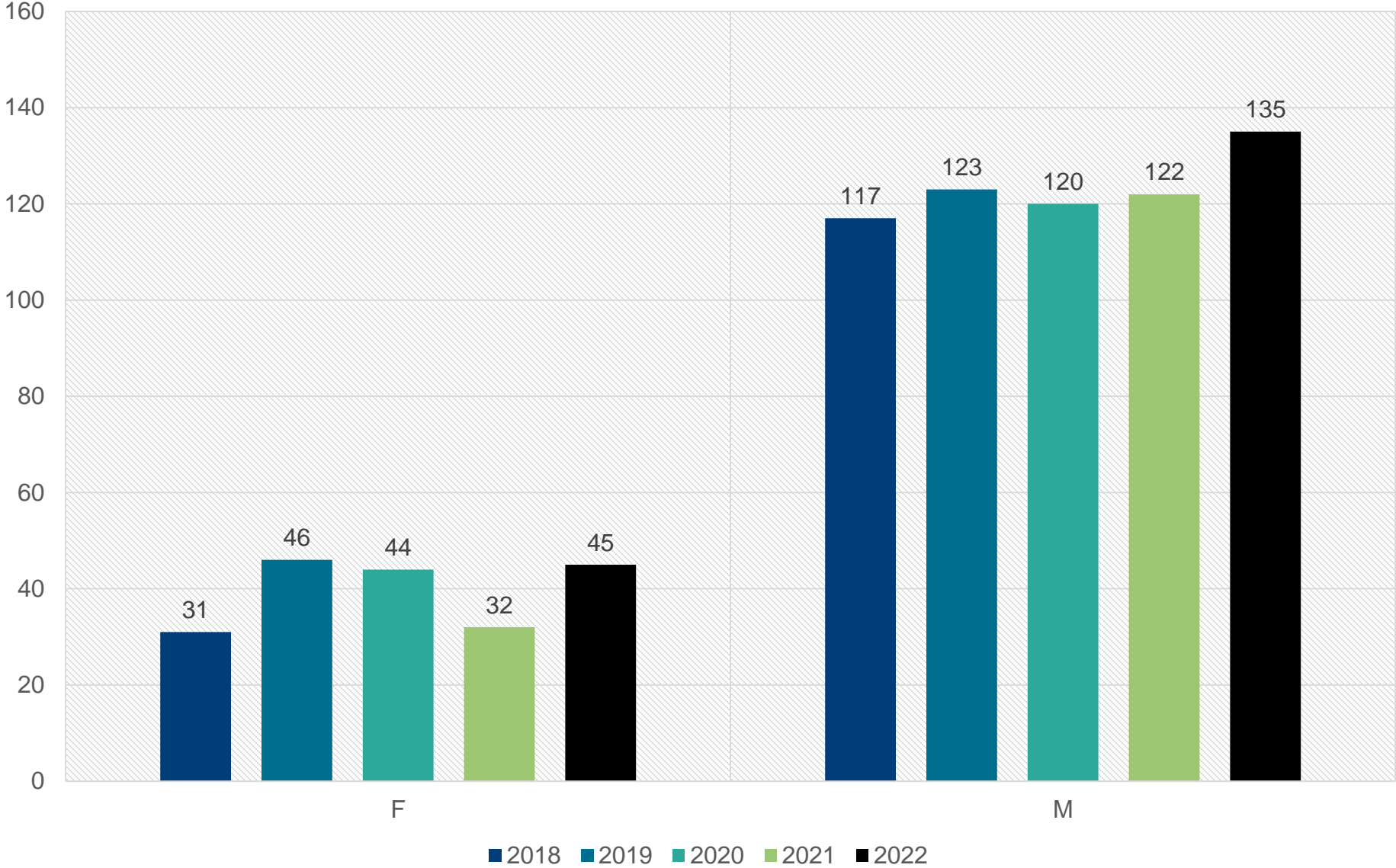
Yearly Suicide Rate per 100,000 by Age Range



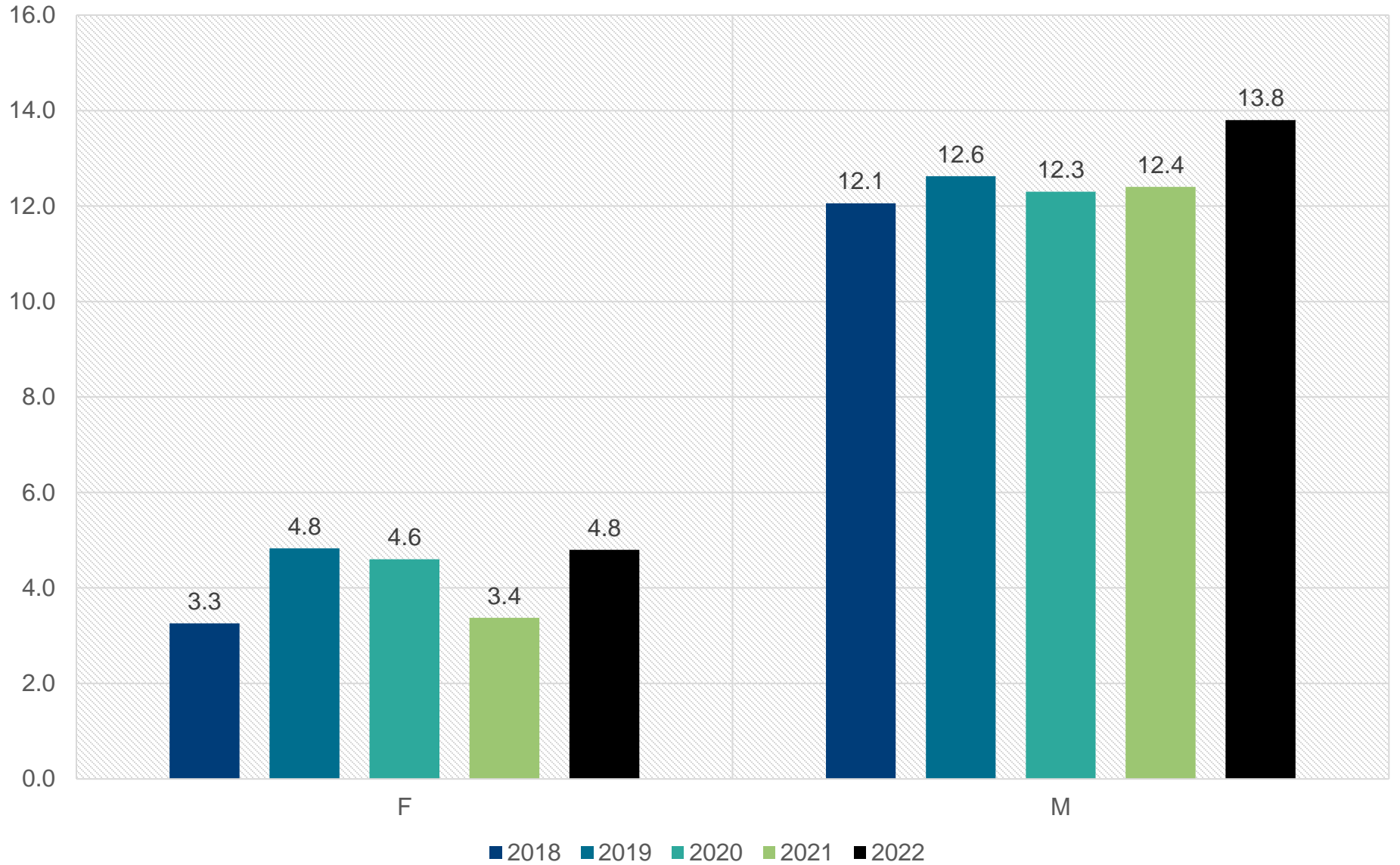
Yearly Percentage of Suicides by Age Range



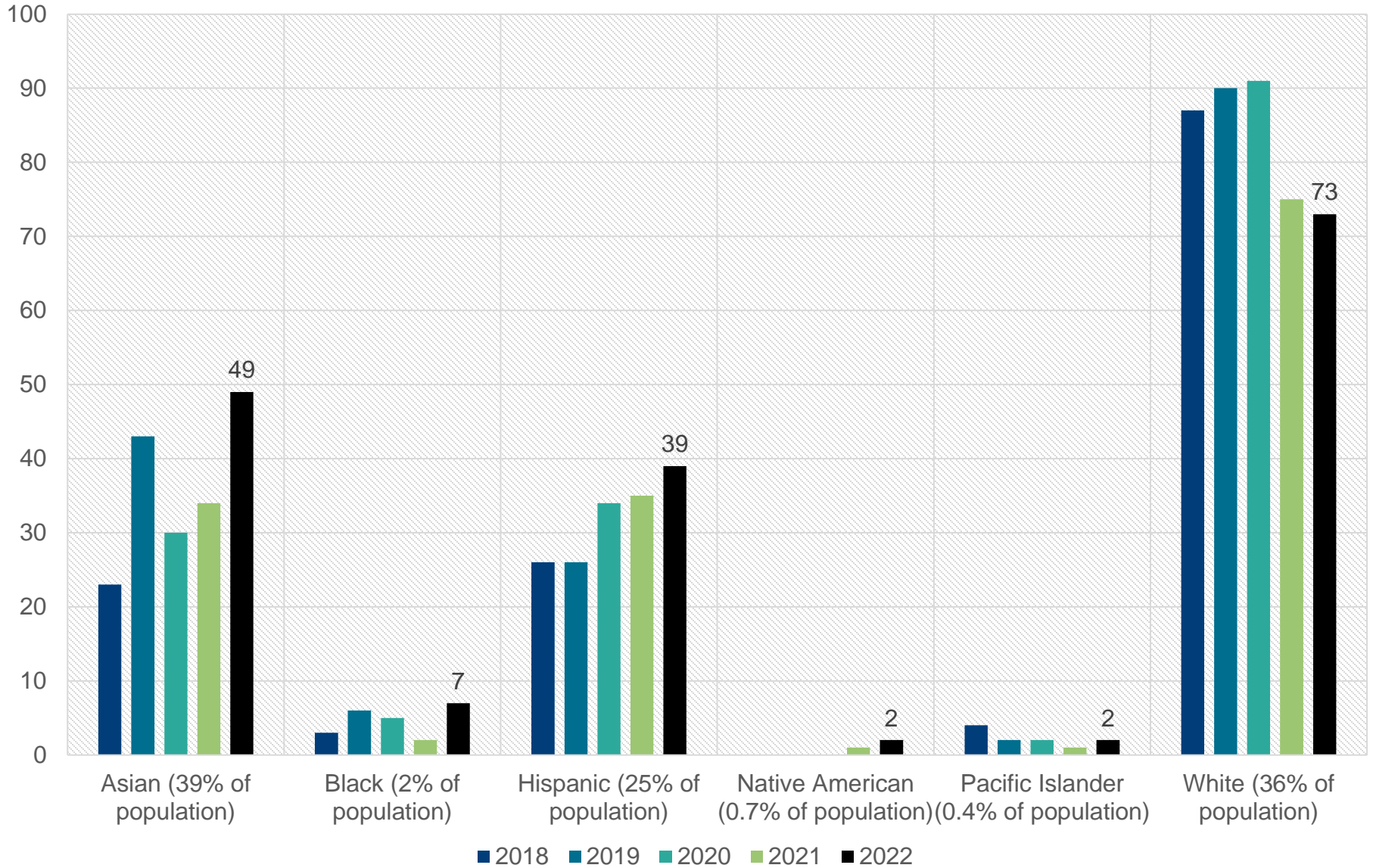
Yearly Suicide Count by Gender



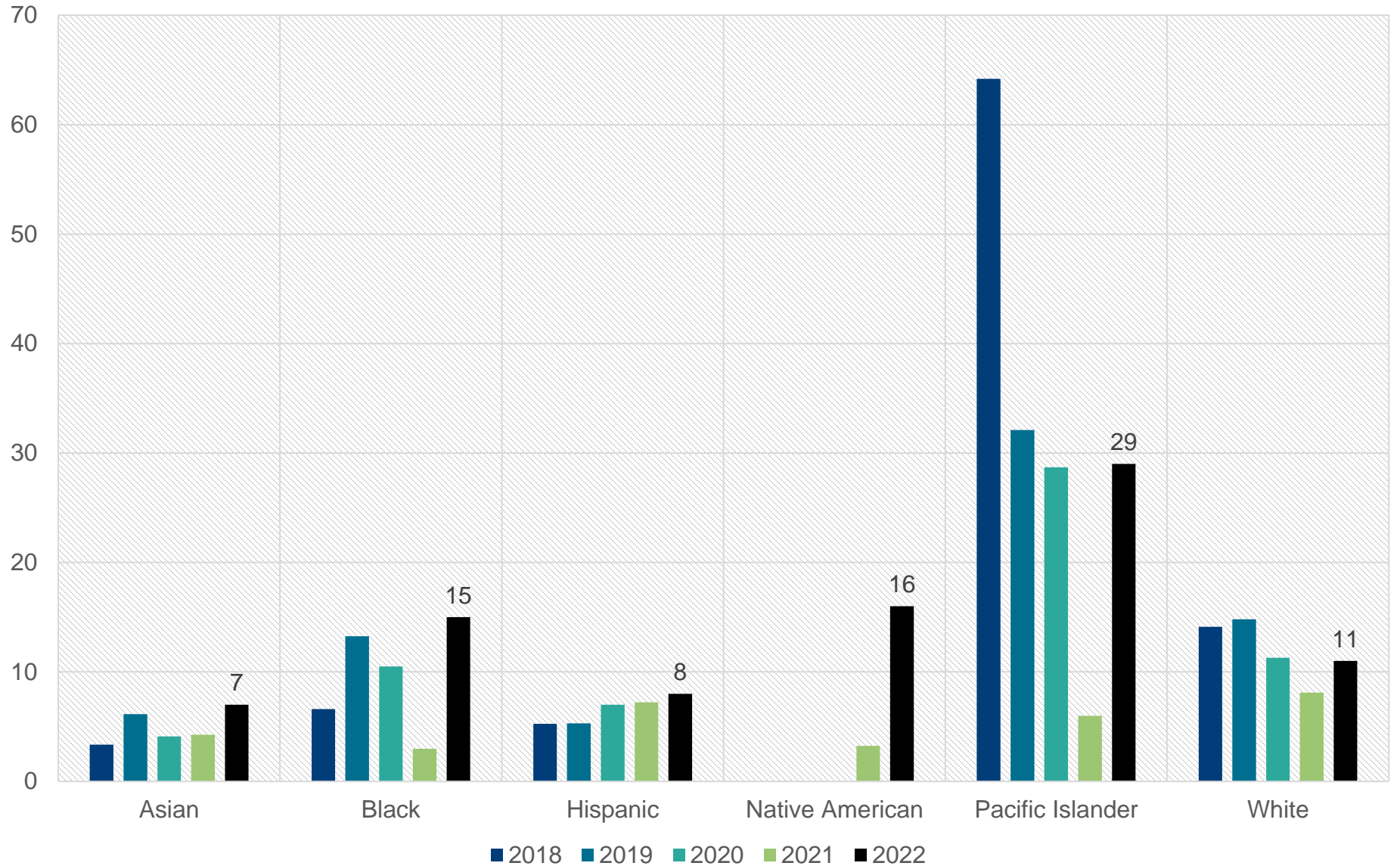
Yearly Suicide Rate per 100,000 by Gender



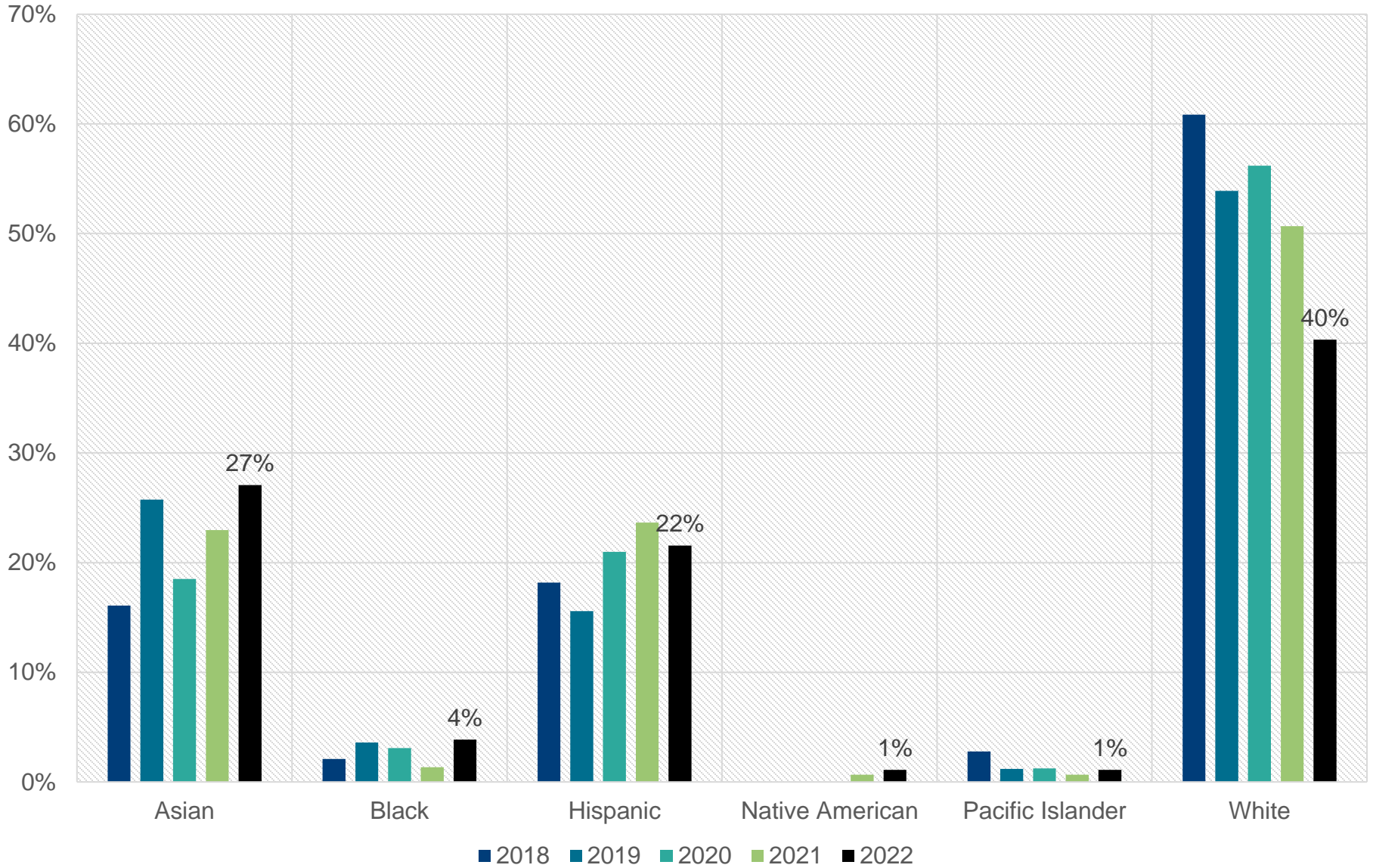
Yearly Suicide Count by Race/Ethnicity



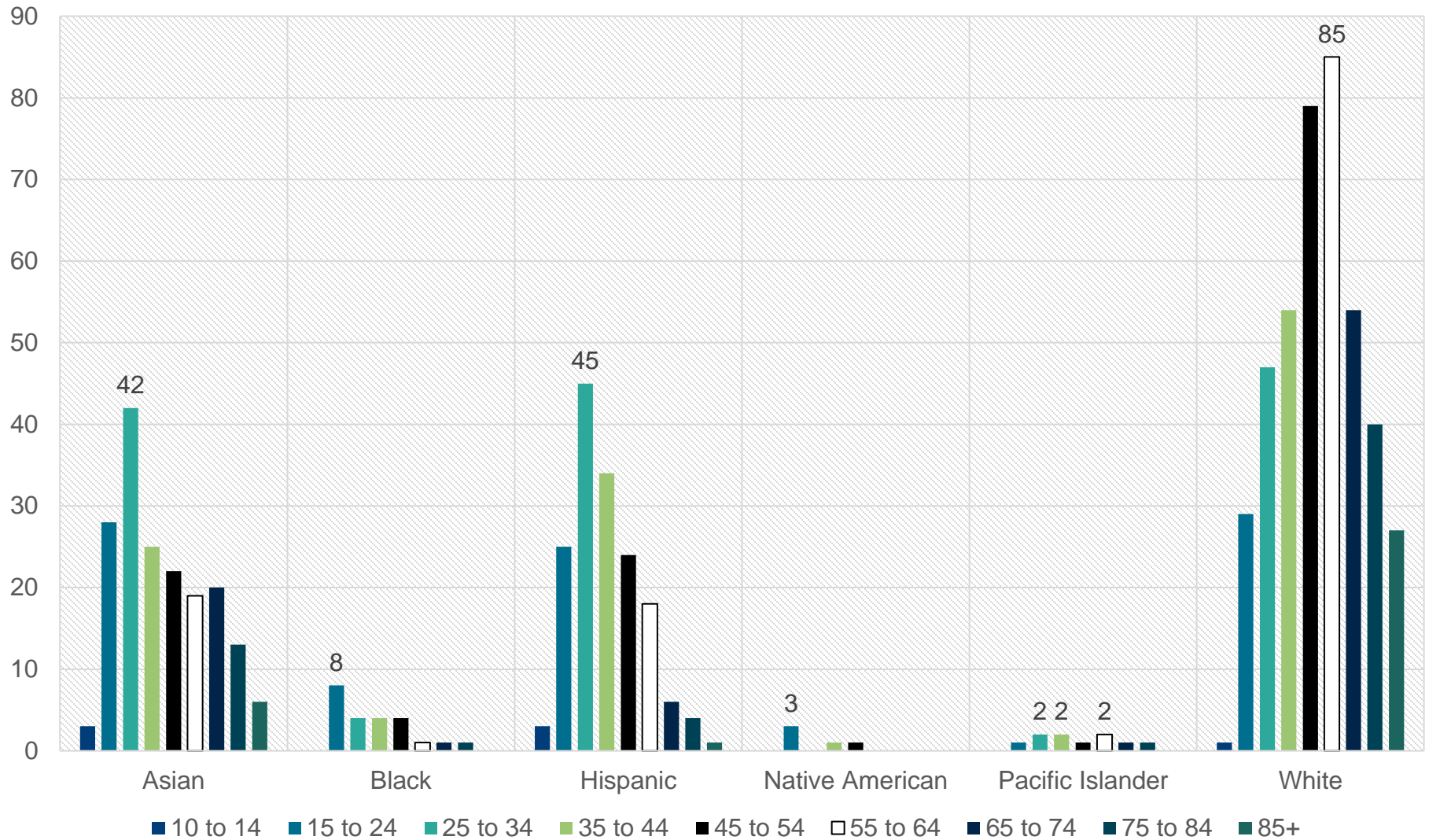
Yearly Suicide Rate per 100,000 by Race/Ethnicity



Yearly Percentage of Suicides by Race/Ethnicity

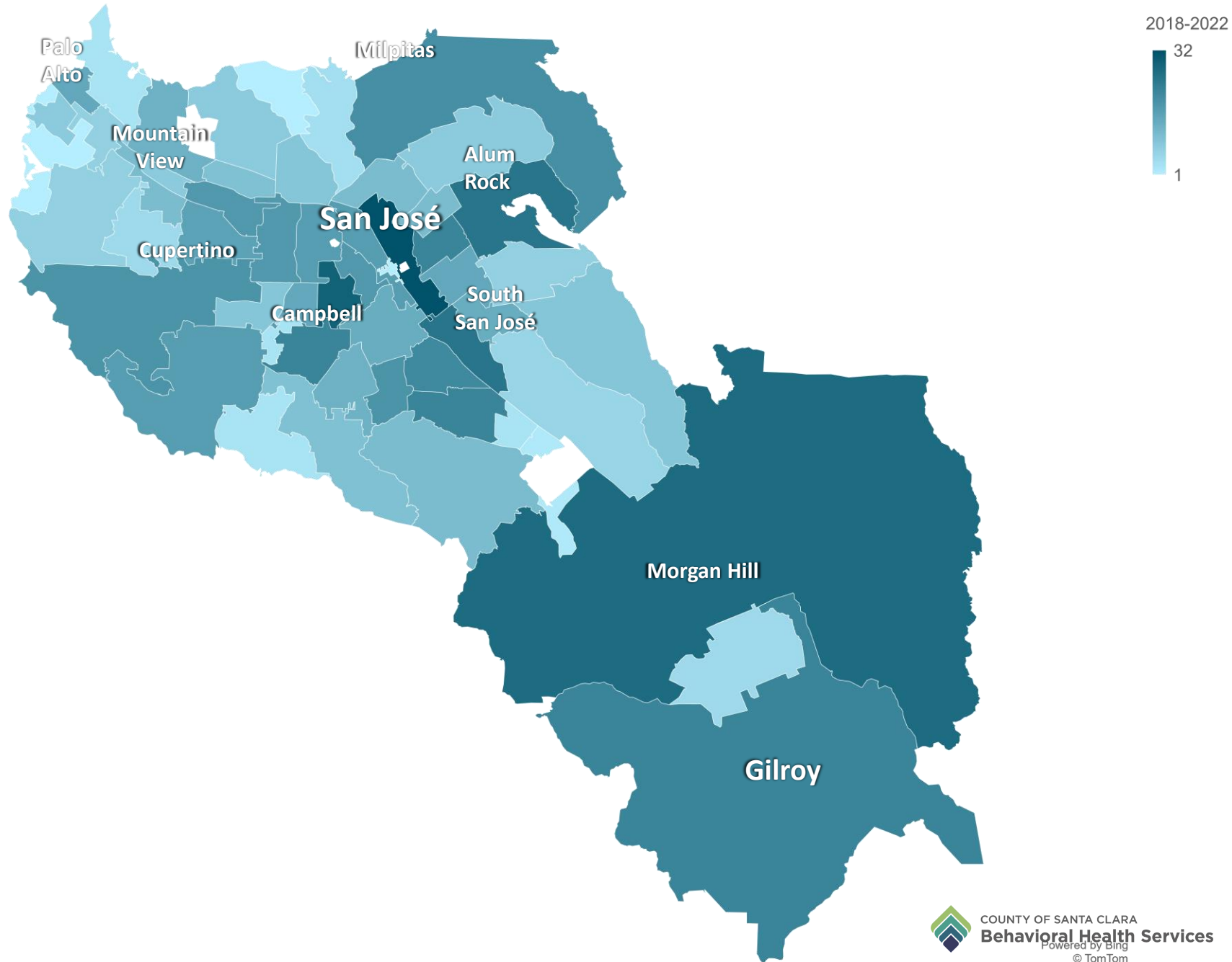


2018-2022 Combined Suicide Counts by Race/Ethnicity & Age



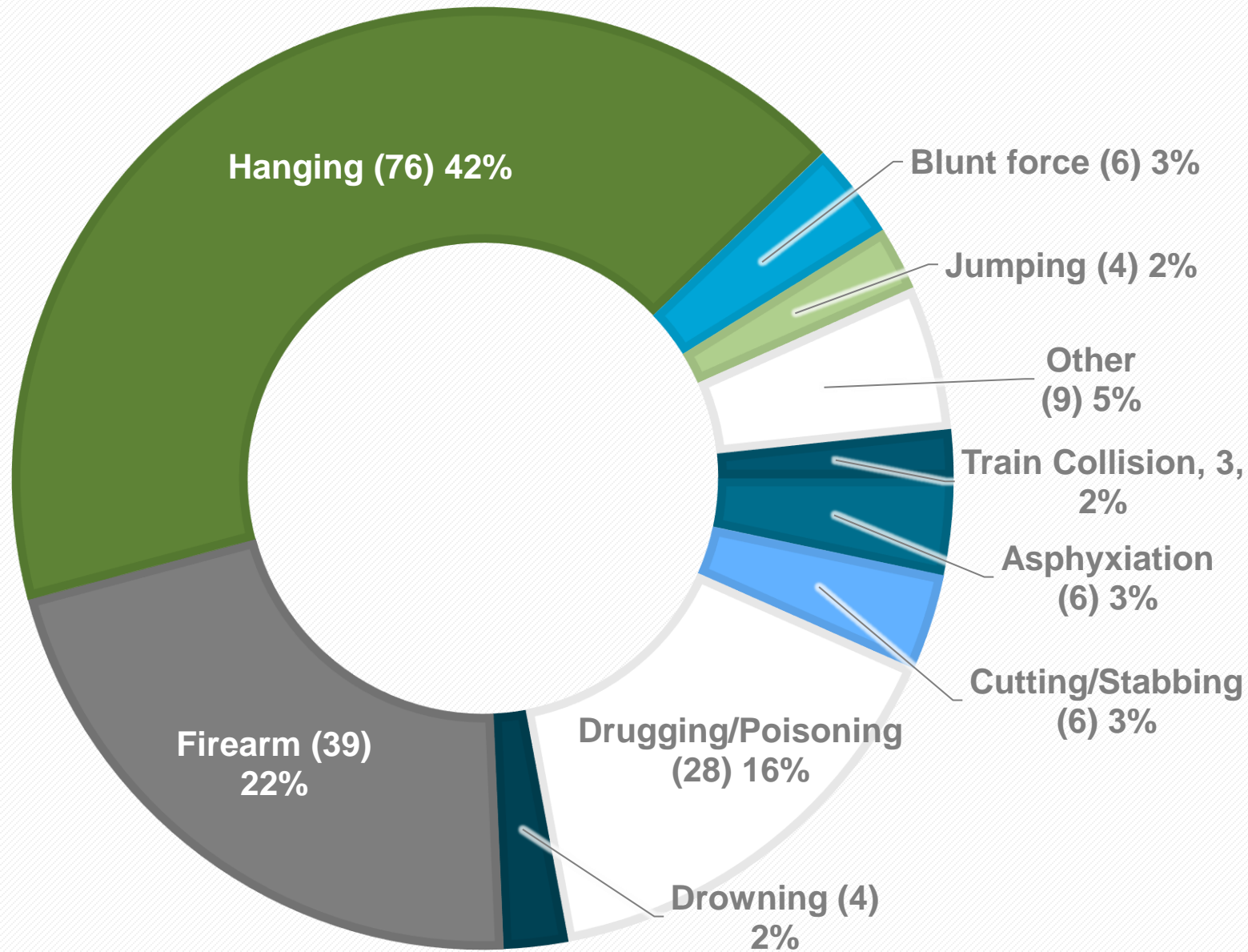
Analysis by Suicide Decedents' City of Residence

2018-2022 Suicide Deaths by Residence Zip Code



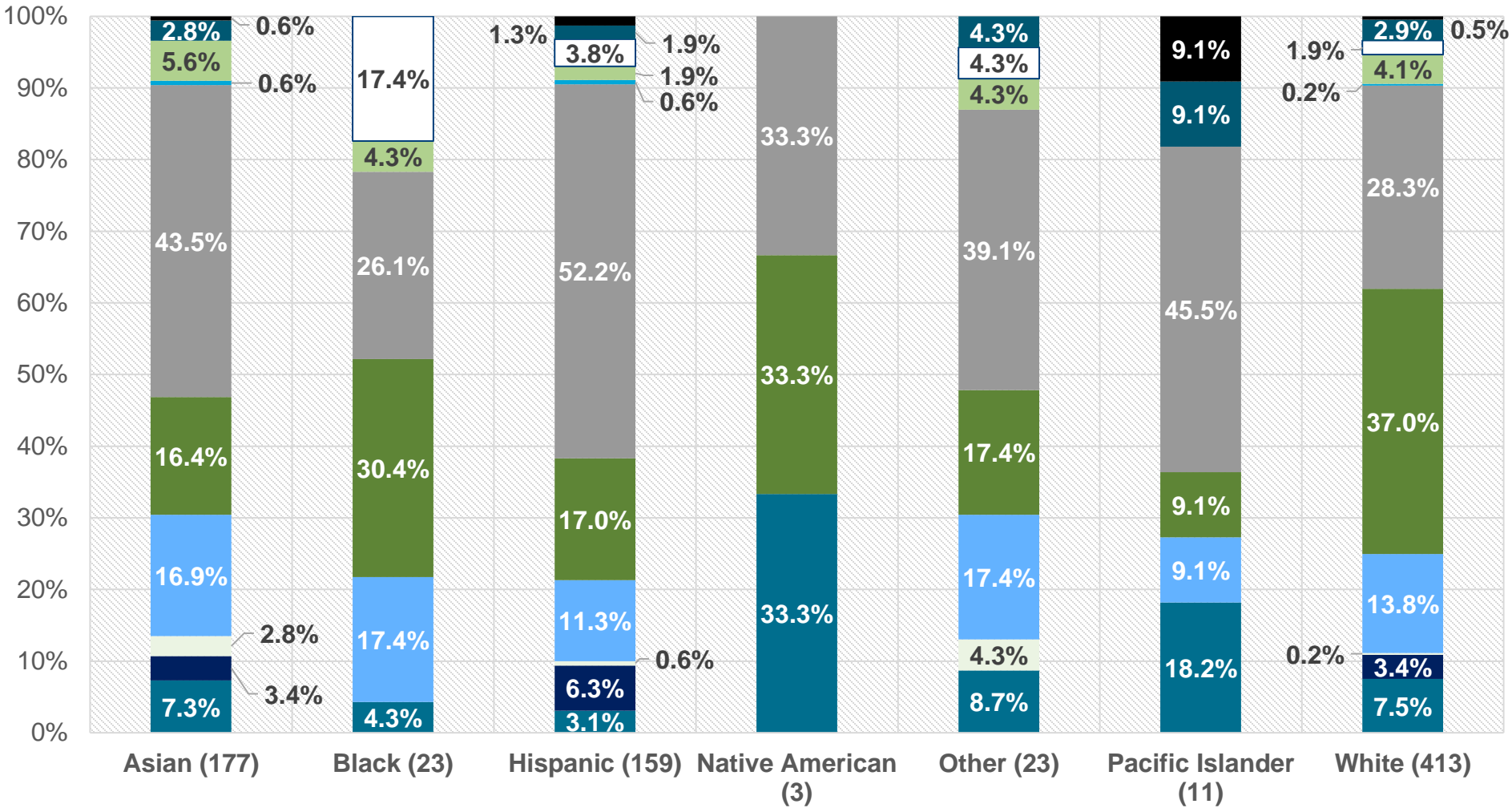

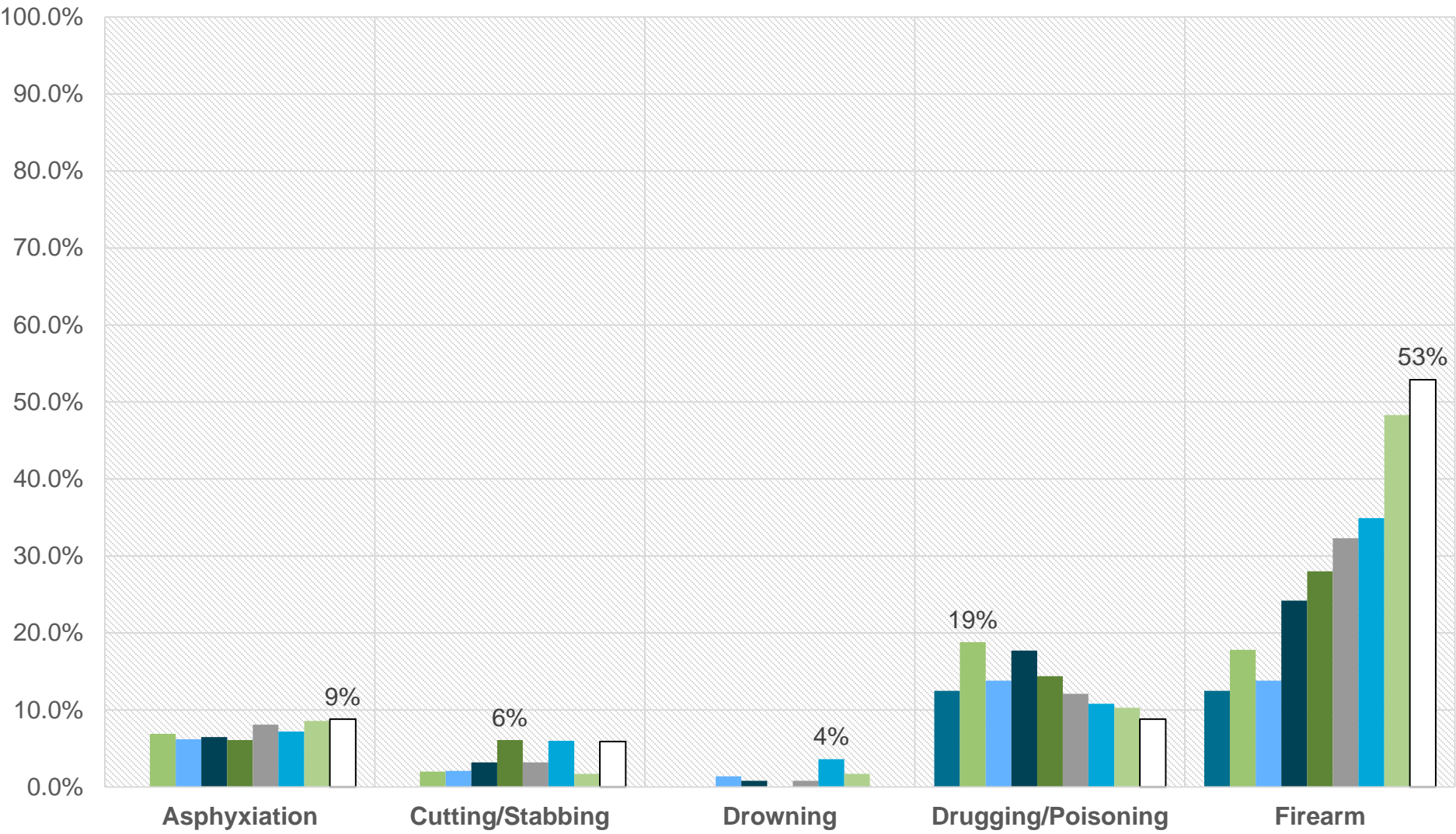

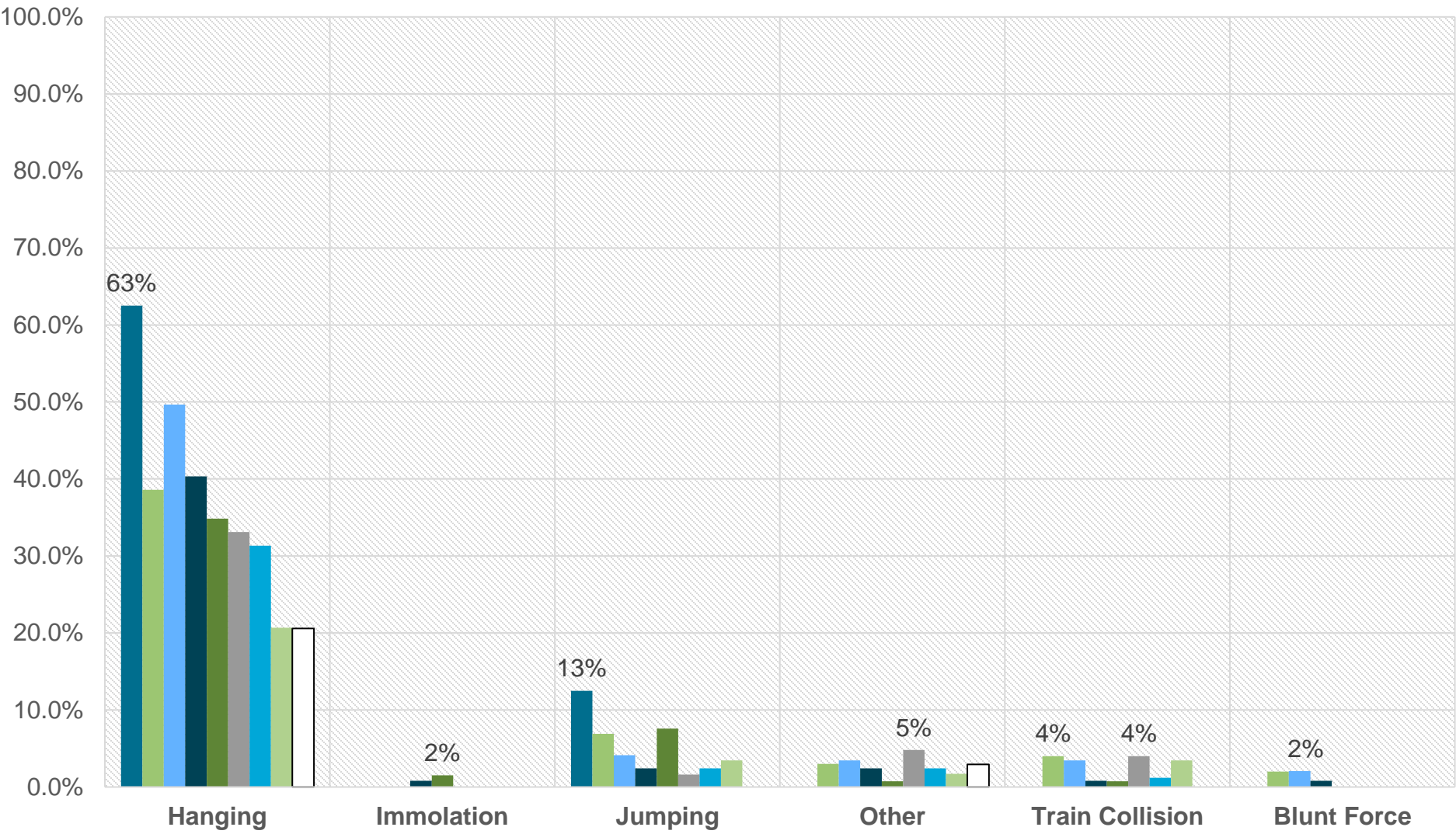

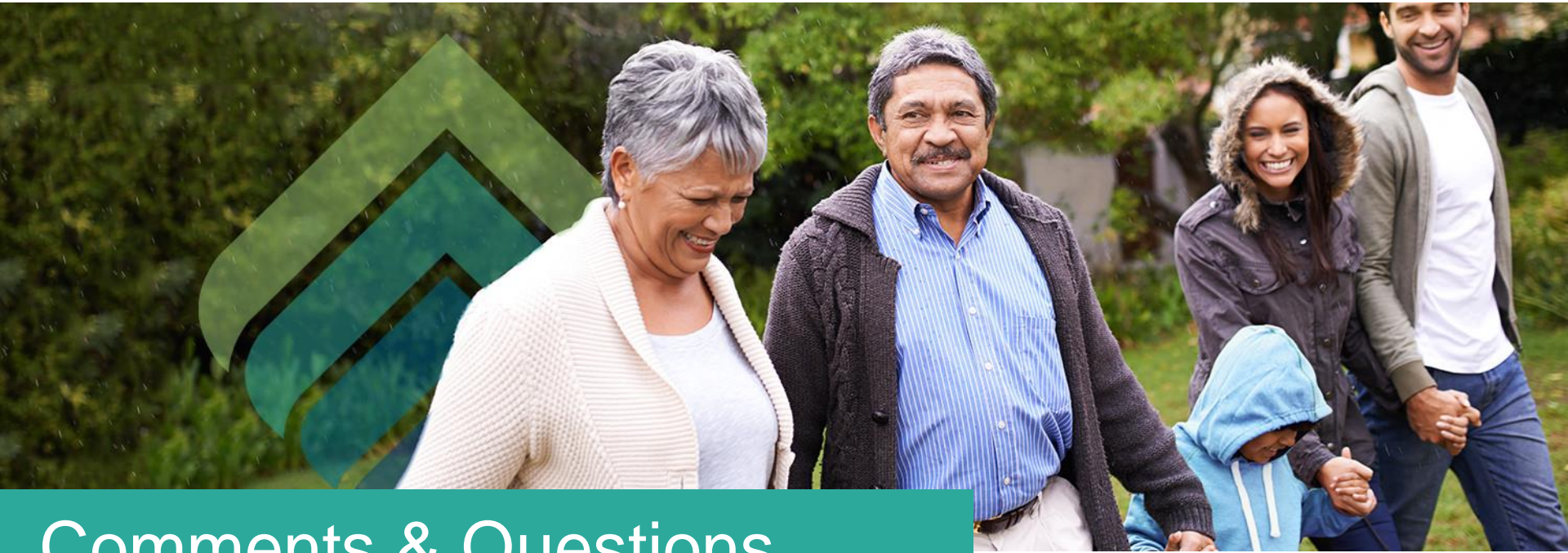
