**Annual Military Equipment Use Report**

**July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024**

**1. Use and Purpose of the Military Equipment**

AB 481 does not define the term “use” for purposes of annual reporting requirements. For purposes of this annual report, the District Attorney’s Office (DAO) adopts the commonly understood meaning of the term and defines “use” as the intentional or unintentional discharge or impact of specified equipment by a person in response to an incident requiring investigator or enforcement action.

During the current reporting period, the military equipment covered by this Annual Report was not used during any investigator event.

**2. Community Complaints or Concerns**

The DAO did not receive any complaints regarding the use of the military equipment during the period covered by this Annual Report.

**3. Audits/Policy Violations**

Since the Board of Supervisors approved the DAO’s policy regarding the Funding, Acquisition and Use of Military Equipment on October 17, 2023, the DAO has implemented a method to audit equipment use and track community complaints as required by Government Code 7070. There were no policy violations during the current reporting period.

**4. Annual Costs**

The DAO incurred the following costs during the reporting period:

\$29,587.85	Purchase of ammunition to be used for authorized training and field operations.
\$20,657.85	Purchase of ten (10) rifles with accessories, bringing the total inventory to twenty (20) rifles.

**5. Quantify of Each Type of Military Equipment Covered by this Report.**

The DAO maintains twenty (20) Colt 6920 AR-15 Series Rifles.

**6. Additional Acquisitions of Military Equipment**

The DAO expects to incur the following costs in FY 24/25:

\$33,840	Purchase of ammunition to be used for authorized training and field operations.
\$14,874.69	Trade-in and purchase of ten (10) replacement rifles and accessories.
