Civic Center North

Take a walk through this historic neighborhood and part of Downtown Gilroy.

DISTANCE 1.3 MILES

DIFFICULTY ●○○○○

From the **Gilroy Senior Center**, head west on W 6th St. Make a right on Princevalle St and pass by **Wheeler Manor**. Turn right on 5th St. On the right is ① **WHEELER HOSPITAL**, a Mediterranean Revival style building that was the site of Gilroy's first hospital [1929-1989]. Continue east on 5th St while admiring the historic homes along the way. Stop at the corner of 5th St and Church St. On the right is the former ② **UNITED PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH**, originally the second oldest Presbyterian church in California, now home to the Salvation Army community center with programming and food distribution. Across the street at 195 5th St is the ③ **CARNEGIE LIBRARY** building, which was the Gilroy Free Library from 1910-1975. Step inside the building, now a museum, to see artifacts and learn more about Gilroy's history. Continue walking east on 5th St. On the left is ④ **THE OLD FIREHOUSE** located at 55 5th St. This was an active firehouse station until 1978 and is now a restaurant. Continue east on 5th St, make a right on Monterey Hwy, and head south. Stop at the ⑤ **GILROY HISTORICAL PASEO** on the right to admire the murals and read about the history of Gilroy throughout the years. Continue south on Monterey Hwy toward ⑥ **OLD CITY HALL**, at 7400 Monterey St. This was used for all city business until 1958 and it is now a restaurant. Make a right on W 6th St and head west to return to the Gilroy Senior Center.
