A local Pilot Examiner, Regional Runway Safety Manager, Air Traffic Controllers and Air Traffic Manager at Reid Hillview Tower will discuss the specific areas that have historically been problem areas or ‘hot spots’ for surface navigation problems.**

**AWP Regional Runway Safety Program Manager, Joe Santoro, will provide an overview of runway incursions at RHV. Additionally learn about the new runway safety products including *Runway Safety Pilot Simulator* and the *From the Flight Deck / Know Before You Go* runway safety initiative that allows you to gain a pilot’s perspective of taxi operations at many airports before you go**
