

Project Overview

- Located at 231 Grant Ave, Palo Alto (County-owned property)
- Proposed demolition of existing 6,800 sf office building
- Proposed construction of a four-story building that includes
 - Approximately 110 residential units
 - 1,200 sf flex space (potential retail or commercial use)
 - Parking structure
 - Bicycle parking
 - Modular construction



Environmental Impact Report (EIR)

EIR — Informational document for providing public agencies and public with detailed information as follows:


- The effects of the proposed project on the environment
- Ways in which the significant effects can be mitigated or avoided
- Alternatives to the proposed project that could reduce or eliminate significant effects

Purpose of EIR Scoping

- To allow the public and agencies to provide input on the project scope and content of the project's environmental impact analysis.
- Scoping comments inform the scope and nature of the CEQA environmental analysis.




