## Paramedic Accreditation

### PARAMEDIC ACCREDITATION (RENEWAL)

This checklist is for Paramedic Accreditation (Renewal) for any licensed Paramedic within the State of California who wishes to maintain continuous accreditation with the Santa Clara County EMS Agency. In order for an online application to be accepted and processed, the following items must be submitted by the applicant via the online Credentialing Portal.

The requirements for each item contained in this checklist may be reviewed in *Santa Clara County Prehospital Care Policy # 205: Paramedic Accreditation*.

- A Paramedic Accreditation application must be completed and digitally signed via the online Credentialing Portal by the Applicant. All documents contained below must be attached digitally:

- Attach a digital copy (front and back) of two (2) government issued photo identifications:

LIST A	LIST B
Driver's license or ID card issued by a State or outlying possession of the United States	Original or certified copy of birth certificate issued by a State, county, municipal authority, or territory of the United States bearing an official seal
U.S. Military identification card or Military dependent's identification card	Certification of Birth Abroad issued by the Department of State
U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport Card	Certification of Report of Birth issued by the Department of State
Permanent Resident (Alien) Card	Social Security Account Number card

- Attach a digital copy (front and back) of current State of California Paramedic card.
- The Paramedic Accreditation processing fee of \$40.00 must be paid through the online payment system.

Online applications will be processed when all required information is complete, including receipt of background clearance from the Department of Justice and Federal Bureau of Investigation. On-site pick up of credential is not available.
