<b>DATES</b>	<b>ACTIVITIES / DOCUMENTS</b>
January 15, 2020 – April 14, 2020 (E-90 to E)	<b><u>CONTRIBUTION / INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES</u></b> Sums of \$1,000 or more to/from a single source must be reported within 24 hours. The Independent Expenditure report is required only for committees (not candidate controlled) that make independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more to support or oppose a single ballot measure or a single candidate.
January 17, 2020 (E-88)	<b><u><sup>1</sup>DUE DATE FOR MEASURE RESOLUTIONS AND TAX RATE STATEMENTS</u></b> Deadline for jurisdictions to submit resolution calling for a measure election, and if applicable, tax rate statements.  <b><u>DUE DATE FOR PROPONENTS TO WITHDRAW AN INITIATIVE</u></b> Deadline for proponents to withdraw an initiative that qualified for the ballot.
January 21, 2020 (E-84)	<b><u><sup>1</sup>DUE DATE FOR ARGUMENTS</u></b> Deadline set by the Registrar of Voters for submitting arguments in favor of and against a measure.
January 22, 2020 (E-83)	<b><u>LAST DAY TO REMOVE A LOCAL MEASURE FROM THE BALLOT</u></b> Deadline to remove a local measure from the ballot.
<u>January 22, 2020– January 31, 2020</u> (E-83 to E-74)	<b><u><sup>1</sup>EXAMINATION PERIOD FOR ALL ARGUMENTS FILED</u></b> The elections official shall make the arguments available for public examination for a period of 10-calendar days immediately following the filing deadline for submission of those documents.
January 28, 2020 (E-77)	<b><u><sup>1</sup>DUE DATE FOR REBUTTALS AND IMPARTIAL ANALYSES</u></b> Deadline set by the Registrar of Voters for submitting rebuttals to arguments in favor of and against a measure and impartial analyses.
<u>January 29, 2020– February 7, 2020</u> (E-76 to E-67)	<b><u><sup>1</sup>EXAMINATION PERIOD FOR ALL REBUTTALS FILED</u></b> The elections official shall make the rebuttal arguments available for public examination for a period of 10-calendar days immediately following the filing deadline for submission of those documents.
<u>February 10, 2020</u> (E-64)	<b><u><sup>1</sup>FINAL PRINTING DEADLINE</u></b> Any petition for writ of mandate, including any appeals, should be resolved by this date so the Registrar of Voters can meet necessary election deadlines.
March 5, 2020 (E-40)	<b><u>F.P.P.C. 1<sup>ST</sup> PRE-ELECTION STATEMENT DUE</u></b> Deadline for financial disclosure report Form 460 covering the period of 1/1/20 to 1/18/20.

This calendar may not contain all district filing requirements. The Office of the Registrar of Voters is not open for filings on Saturday, Sunday or holidays.

<sup>2</sup>The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, OR January 1<sup>st</sup>, if no previous statement has been filed.

<sup>3</sup>Date falls on a weekend or public holiday; deadlines move forward to the next business day.

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March 16, 2020 (E-29)	<b><u>FIRST DAY FOR MAILING OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</u></b> First day of mailing of Vote by Mail ballots.
March 16, 2020– April 13, 2020 (E-29 to E-1)	<b><u>EARLY VOTING PERIOD AT THE ROV OFFICE</u></b> Early voting is available at the Registrar of Voters Office during normal business hours, Monday - Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., beginning 29 days before the election.
<sup>3</sup> April 1, 2020 (E-14)	<b><u>LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE FOR APRIL ELECTION</u></b> Deadline to register to be eligible to vote in the April 14, 2020 Election.
April 2, 2020 (E-12)	<b><u>F.P.P.C. 2<sup>ND</sup> PRE-ELECTION STATEMENT DUE</u></b> Deadline for financial disclosure report Form 460 covering the period of <sup>2</sup> 3/1/20 to 3/28/20.
April 4, 2020– April 13, 2020 (E-10 to E-1)	<b><u>VOTE CENTERS OPEN 10 DAYS BEFORE ELECTION DAY</u></b> Vote Centers are open to all registered voters in Santa Clara County. Any voter can go to any Vote Center location throughout the County. Hours vary by location – <a href="#">please see listing</a> on our website at <a href="http://sccvote.com">sccvote.com</a> .
April 7, 2020 (E-7)	<b><u>LAST DAY TO REQUEST VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT TO BE MAILED</u></b> Deadline at 5:00 p.m. to submit a request for a Vote by Mail ballot to be mailed to voter.
April 14, 2020 (E)	<b><u>ELECTION DAY</u></b> All Vote Centers and ROV Office are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. for voting.
May 6, 2020 (E+22)	<b><u>LAST DAY ELECTIONS OFFICIAL TO NOTIFY VOTER OF VERIFICATION OF SIGNATURE</u></b> In the case of a voter whose signatures do not match, the elections official is required to notify the voter, at least 8 days before the certification of the election, of an opportunity to verify the voter's signature.
May 12, 2020 (E+28)	<b><u>SIGNATURE VERIFICATION DATE</u></b> Last day to turn in unsigned ballot or signature verification statements.
May 14, 2020 (E+30)	<b><u>OFFICIAL CANVASS OF VOTE</u></b> Registrar of Voters to certify election results by May 14, 2020.

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
