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Why get tested

1 in 20 young people have chlamydia, & most do not have symptoms.



- Chlamydia infections are raising each year and are very common.
- A chlamydia infection can cause damage to the body if it is not treated with antibiotics.

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How to get tested

- Testing is simple and easy.
- To complete this test, go to any VMC Laboratory and give a urine sample.

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How often you should get tested

- Health experts in the United States recommend that every woman less than 25 years old get a chlamydia test **once each year**.
- You should take this test even if you have no symptoms such as discharge, pelvic pain, pain while peeing, or unusual bleeding.
- You need this test even if you have not been sexually active in the past year.
