Legislators see many bills into law

• SB 369 by Joe Simitian, D-Palo Alto, extends the existing law that authorizes the California Integrated Waste Management Board to implement a program to award grants to cities, counties, districts and other local governmental agencies for the funding of public works projects that use rubberized asphalt concrete. The existing grant program, which provides about \$1.6 million to local governments annually, will become inoperative on June 30, 2006 and repealed on Jan. 1, 2007. SB 369 extends the Jan. 1, 2007 sunset date to Jan. 1, 2011.
