of vulnerable youth living in kinship and foster settings have children of their own by the time they turn 19, and an additional 28% have them by 21.

20%

of vulnerable youth living in kinship and foster settings are referred for substance abuse treatment by the time they turn 19, and an additional 13% are by 21.

38%

of vulnerable youth living in kinship and foster settings find themselves incarcerated by the time they turn 19, and an additional 27% do by 21.

62%

of vulnerable youth living in kinship and foster settings are unemployed when they turn 19, and 47% are at 21.

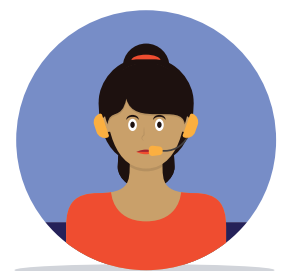
Short-on-time caregivers can access an everything-in-one place web portal 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and find the resources and services their kinship families need.
