
Community Meeting #1 Summary

- First Community Meeting held on October 16, 2019
- All the feedback received via post-it notes at the previous meeting and by email, were posted on the SCC Roads and Airports website and placed into the following four categories:
 - 1. Referred to CHP or partner agency
 - 2. Considered in study
 - 3. Out of scope
 - 4. Comment noted
- Majority advocated for speed humps, speed display signs, and program visibility (pv) signal head for the stop light at the intersection of MacArthur Ave and Stevens Creek Blvd.


Traffic Engineering Evaluation and Outreach

- Notification was sent on December 4, 2019 to all residents located within 100ft of the proposed speed hump locations
- The notification provided residents with information on the placement of the proposed speed humps
- In addition, Engineers went door to door to obtain maximum resident participation
- Other issues outside the County jurisdiction were referred to the respective agency


MacArthur Avenue




Speed Hump Location (Rendering)
