If you answered yes to all the questions above, move on to step 2.
Step 2 : Collect all the information needed for your application (check the application form)
Step 3 : If you do not have a County Vendor ID, after approval you must fill out the vendor set up through DocuSign packet sent to you via email.
Step 4 : Review the application process to understand what to expect once the application is submitted
Step 5: Submit your application to CSW@ceo.sccgov.org
Step 6 : If approved, submit a report on event/project final outcomes before the end of the fiscal year July 1 st -June 30 in which the application was approved.
