SANTA CLARA COUNTY, CALIF – The County of Santa Clara Registrar of Voters will be hosting Candidate School Seminars next week in anticipation of the November 8, 2022 General Election. All potential candidates are invited to attend, where they can get up-to-date information on the candidate filing process.

The 90-minute workshops will be held virtually using the Zoom application and are open to anyone interested in seeking elective office in Santa Clara County.
