SCHOOL LINKED SERVICES

SLS Family Engagement (SLS FE)

The SLS Family Engagement program provides students and their families with school-based coordinated services to address the needs and well-being gaps of families through a community participatory approach.

SLS Coordinator(s), located at the school district or a school site, develop partnership with schools, public agencies, and community-based organization in Santa Clara County to improve protective factors (e.g., family relationship), decrease risk-factors (e.g., behavioral, and emotional problems), enhance service accessibility and resource linkage, and to support children's success in school and in life. The SLS Coordinators and the Family Engagement program aligns with the MTSS Tier 1 level of support where universal support strategies are provided to all.



Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI)

The Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) program provides services including parent coaching and workshops, skills building through Skills Streaming and groups, in-class behavioral support, parent navigation support (case management), and short-term individual therapy. The PEI program aligns with the MTSS Tier 2 level of support where targeted supplemental supports are available to address risk.

Parenting classes include but are not limited to:

- Strengthening Families Program – teaches parenting skills and children's life skills in a positive environment to increase family strengths and resilience.
- Triple P Positive Parenting Program – educates parents, providing resources and tools for them to use with their children in a healthy social and emotional context.

SLS Behavioral Health (SLS BH)

SLS Behavioral Health (SLS BH) program provides therapeutic, evidence-based services, such as individual, family, and/or group therapy, in a school, home, and/or community setting to school-aged youth who meet the criteria of medical necessity and are Medi-Cal eligible.

In addition to therapeutic services, the program provides targeted case management, medication support, and crisis intervention for students admitted into the program. The SLS BH program aligns with the MTSS Tier 3 level of support where select students receive intensive support to remediate significant challenges.

Additional programs under SLS Behavioral Health include the Unconditional Education and Social, Emotional and Academic Services programs, providing similar services to the SLS BH program.
