SUBJECT: Applications by Transportation Agency to FAA for
Airport Improvement Projects at South County and Reid-Hillview Airports

A. RECOMMENDED ACTION

At its regular meeting of March 5, 1984, the Santa Clara County Airports Commission voted unanimously to recommend to the Board of Supervisors the approval of two applications to the FAA for improvements at South County and Reid-Hillview Airports.

B. FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The applications are to be submitted to the FAA for a 90% cost funding of the projects. The matching funds will be available within the Aviation Operations budget balances.

C. REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

The Commission finds that these improvements will benefit the airport facilities and result in increased revenues to the County.
