

WATER QUALITY EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION PLAN

No person shall operate a state small water system without an emergency notification plan that has been submitted and approved by the Department of Environmental Health. The emergency notification plan shall provide for immediate notice to the customers of the state water system of any significant rise in the *bacterial count of water* or other failure to comply with any primary drinking standard that represents an imminent danger to the health of the water users.

The standard means of notification of your customers would be door to door contact, written handout sheets, or telephone. Email is not an acceptable method for emergencies. Please indicate your plan below.
